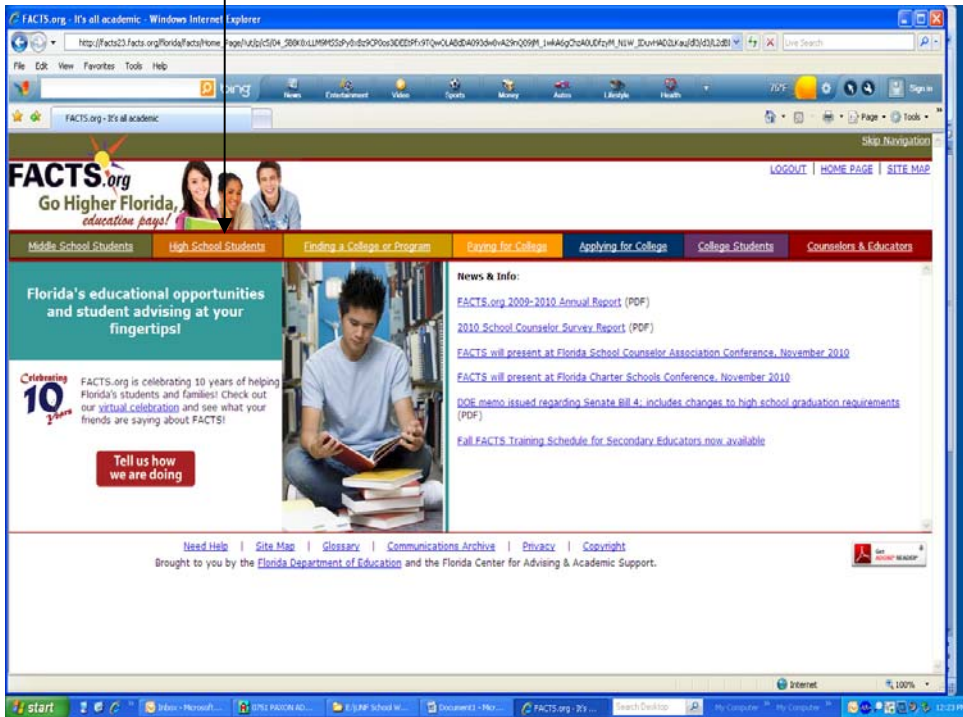

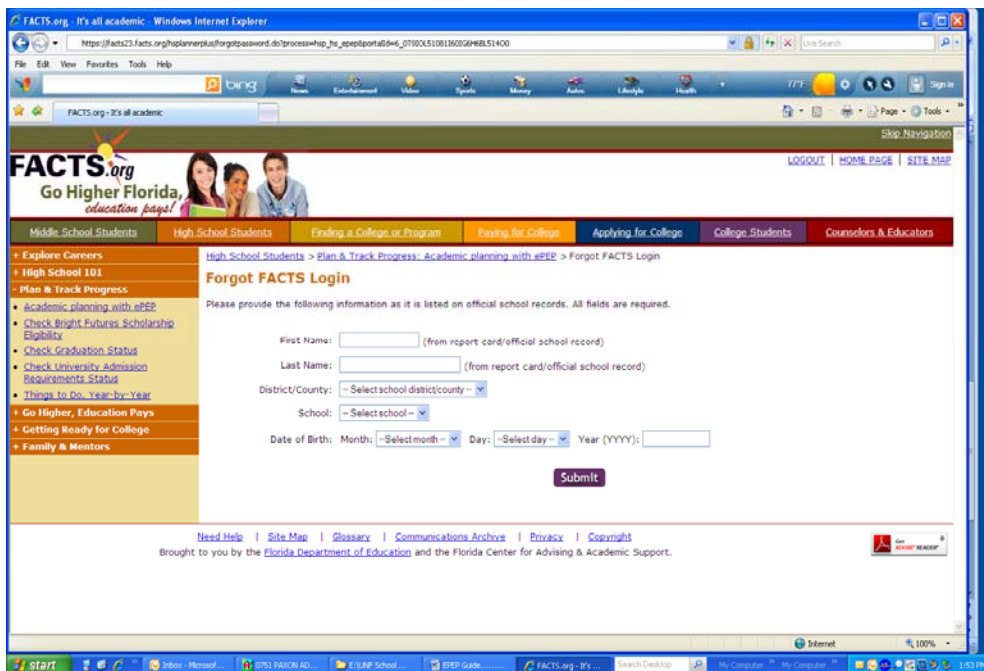

If you have never created a FACTS EPEP click NEW USER

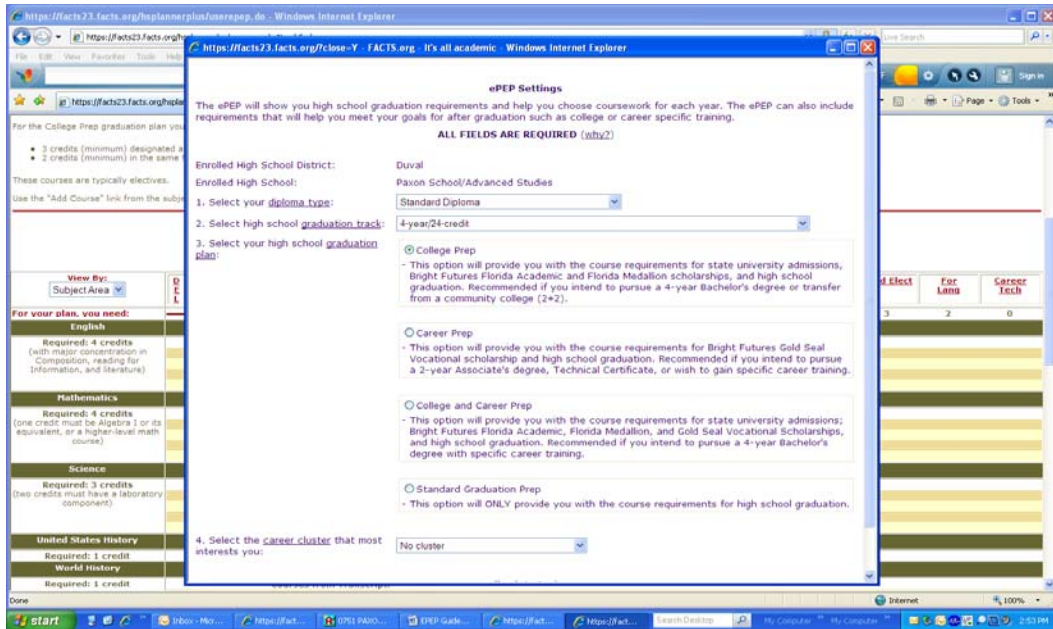


If you forgot your username/password use your social security number with an X at the end for student identifier #.

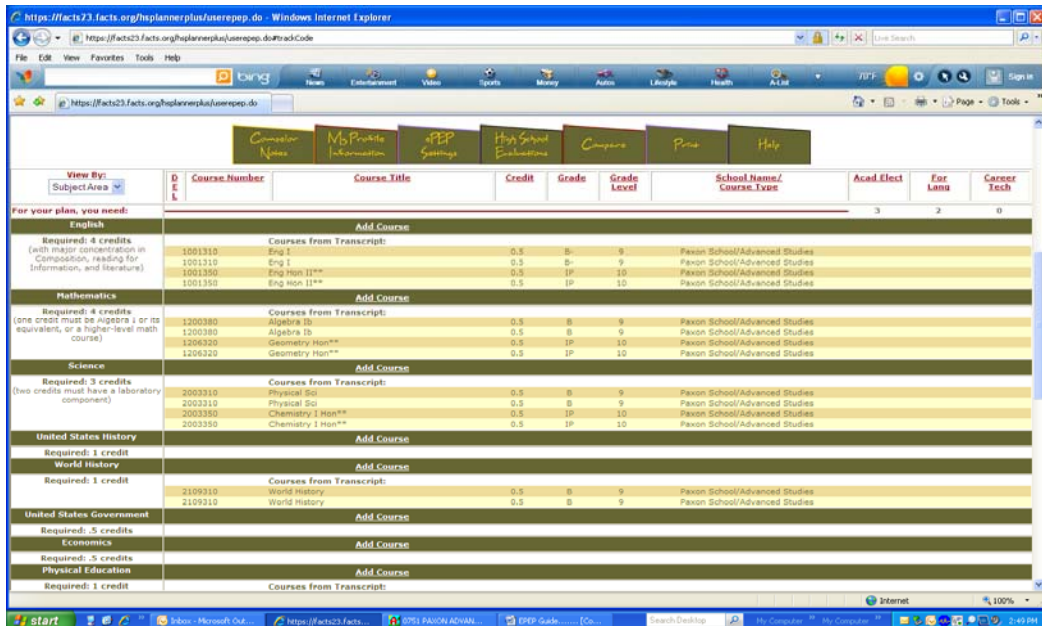
If you are a new user skip to the next slide.

If you are creating a NEW USER go to EPEP settings and input the following:

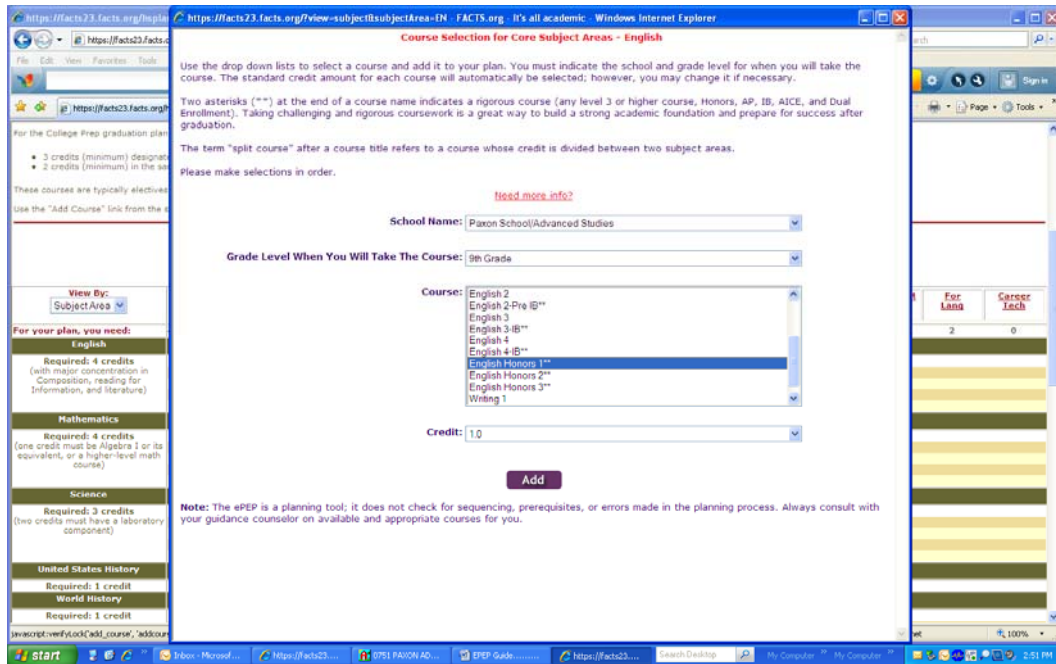
